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Overview

Your safari begins in Nairobi where you will be collected from a location of your choosing by a Wilderness Bookings driver guide in the early morning. Begin your journey to Satao Elerai Camp located on a private 5,000 acre conservancy on the edge of Amboseli National Park. where you will spend 2 nights. Explore various areas of the conservancy on morning, evening and night game drives before you move on to the next destination of your safari - the Ol Pejeta Conservancy and the luxurious Sweetwaters Serena Camp where you will spend 2 nights. During your time here, you will get a chance to discover lots of game on morning and evening game drives with relaxing afternoons by the poolside or watching the nearby water hole.

The 3rd and final leg takes you on to the Maasai Mara Reserve and the intimate Speke's Camp; a great base from which to discover the beauty of this incredible eco-system, the great wildebeest migration and the wide range of other species that make the reserve so famous.

On your last morning, sit down to a final breakfast before you begin your drive back to Nairobi and enjoy one last game drive as you make your way out of the reserve. Once in Nairobi, you will either be transferred to Jomo Kenyatta International Hotel or back to your Nairobi Hotel.

Day 1 & 2: Satao Elerai Camp, Amboseli National Park

Amboseli National Park

The landscape of Amboseli is dominated by the snow cap of Mount Kilimanjaro, open plains, acacia woodland, swamps and the massif of Ol Doinyo Orok. Renowned for its excellent Masai giraffe, elephant, lion and cheetah viewing and not surprisingly it is one of Kenya most popular parks. The birding is excellent especially near the lakes and swamps.

Overnight: Satao Elerai Camp



Wake up in the coolness of the early morning and watch the first few rays of the sun hit the blue Mt. Kilimanjaro, Africa's greatest mountain. Satao Elerai is an eco friendly luxury camp tucked away in the corner of the famous Amboseli Ecosystem, close to the famous Amboseli National Park.

Satao Elerai represents 5 luxury suites and 9 charming canvas tents. The gorgeous lodge style suites feature gently sloping organic walls, built with natural rocks, acacia wood and a carefully constructed thatched roof; large sliding doors opens up to a private verandah overlooking the plains of Elerai Conservancy and the Amboseli National Park. Each suite has a spacious bathroom with private view of the surroundings, hand crafted bathtub, shower, flush toilet and hand wash basin.

Ol Pejeta Conservancy boasts an astounding variety of animals including all the “Big Five” (the endangered black and white rhino, leopard, elephant, buffalo and lion) as well Kenya’s only sanctuary for rescued chimpanzees.

Overnight: Sweetwaters Serena Camp



A sheltered oasis, clustered around a water hole and set in the pristine calm of the private Ol Pejeta Conservancy, Sweetwaters Tented Camp offers a charming blend of under-canvas ambiance and safari luxury.

Located on the plains of Mount Kenya, the camp features thirty-nine luxury tents, each with its own private veranda overlooking the water hole. The central Rhino Restaurant is housed in the former manager's house of this once colonial farm, and offers both regional and international cuisine. Also within the house is the Kashoggi Bar and lounge, which centres on a blazing log fire. The Waterhole Bar, built in the style of a game-viewing hide, overlooks the waterhole and offers unrivalled wildlife-watching.

Day 5 - 7: Speke's Camp, Mara North Conservancy

Mara North Conservancy

Mara North Conservancy is a beautiful private wilderness area of more than 74,000 acres. It is home to a spectacular array of plants, reptiles, birds and mammals; including elephant, rhino, buffalo, lion, leopard, cheetah and large concentrations of wildebeest, zebra, gazelle and other migratory wildlife. Leopard Gorge, in the heart of the conservancy, is famous as the setting of countless BBC Big Cat Diaries and National Geographic documentaries. Bordering the Maasai Mara National Reserve, the conservancy is vital for sustaining the famous Serengeti wildebeest migrations and the highly threatened African wild dog and black rhino.

Overnight: Speke's Camp



Speke's Camp is a small and hosted camp located in a private area of the Maasai Mara on the border of the Reserve; the camp enjoys fabulous access to some of the best gaming areas in the Mara including Rhino Ridge, Musiara Swamp and Paradise Plains.

The eight traditional safari tents with en-suite bathrooms are situated alongside the Olare Orok River under the shade of majestic indigenous trees. Game drives are with first-rate Maasai guides into the National Park and can include bush breakfasts and sundowners. Hot-air ballooning can be arranged with the Head Office before arrival. Speke's charm lies in the fact this is a simple-comfortable traditional safari camp, hosted with all the necessities, yet within an affordable price-bracket.
